
Concept 1: Swiss Punk-ish


According to Wolfgang Weingart, "I took 'Swiss Typography' as my starting point, but then I blew it apart." I like this idea as a starting point for a creativity conference.


Exploration, innovation, play, creativity, motion, emotion; words like these could be incorporated into and interwoven into looping layers of shapes, images, and footage.


This same treatment and type play would be fun to work into a countdown sequence as well.

This same type play would be incorporated into a countdown sequence as well.








Concept 3: Day in the Life of...

National Park College will host an art and design conference to bring together local artists, designers, illustrators, and college faculty to share their experience and wisdom with local high school and college students.


This project will incorporate typography, image, and video footage to serve as a recruitment tool as well as an interest piece to play while attendees are waiting between speaker sessions.




Loop Animation Chosen Direction
